HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR VIDEO:

- 1) Please create your 3-5 minute video that introduces yourself and answers the question:
How do you best express your passion and interest for music?
- 2) **Post your video** on YouTube as an unlisted video
 - a. Upload your video and title it: 2018 PG Scholarship – Your Name (i.e. “2018 PG Scholarship – Jane Smith)
 - b. Go to **Video Manager**
 - c. Select clip and edit access by clicking on the picture of the lock on the right side
 - d. Select **Unlisted**
 - e. Save changes and copy the link URL that is listed
 - f. Paste link into email to lessons@pittsburghguitars.com and attach completed application.
